Building the Inn at Claggett is the final step in fulfilling the direction approved at the Special Convention in the fall of 2001. Monocacy and Sugarloaf Halls were opened in January 2007. Our goal is to break ground in 2013.

- The inn will be 26,300 sq. ft. with 63 guest rooms, all with queen size beds and private baths, and meeting and social spaces.
- The entire complex will be on the same level and be fully accessible. Together, these will be the first fully-accessible buildings at Claggett.
- Claggett has been self-supporting since 1998. From 2008 through 2010, net ordinary income has held steady around \$60,000 after depreciation.
- The addition of the inn will transform the Claggett Campus and broaden significantly the opportunities for ministry. With the inn national church meetings and regional gatherings could now occur at Claggett.
- The inn will enhance Claggett's cash flow and ultimately create \$200,000 or more additional annual net income that can be directed to support youth programs and maintenance of our other 12 buildings, which average in age well over 100 years.
- Clergy support is very positive. To date, 163 clergy have made gifts and pledges totaling more than \$430,000.
